



Something Interesting Is Going On!





A Few Things That Make Us Smile!



Every day at the center, we find a million little things to smile about. They may seem small on the surface, but they symbolize so much more. Below are great examples of what we mean by that.


A New Adventure Just Around the Corner!

Our friends in Nampa engage the natural side of things. From environmental crafts, to sport parks, we hope they continue to explore. Thank you for sharing.





Aleera stands next to a large figure, made entirely from cans removed from the Boise River.

Tanner focuses on block-fest activities. He picked the hardest design and saw this project through to completion!





Marching Into a Bright Future!


On May 6th, 2022, we celebrated our newest Boise State University graduate, Lauren Senske, Lauren walked to receive her Bachelor's of Social Work degree.


